Junior Handler judging will be straight after the end of the Open Show BIS judging.

The Junior Handler section is a club based event and is not part of the NZKC Junior Handler series.

The Judge will consider:-

- (i) The ability of the handler to control the exhibit.
- (ii) The ability of the handler in 'setting up' the dog as an exhibit.
- (iii) The ability of the handler to 'gait' the dog at a desirable pace for the Judge.
- (iv) The dress and ring demeanour of the handler.

The quality of the dog will not be taken into account by the Judge.

Junior Dog Handler Class may be judged by a person or persons other than a Judge on the official list of Judges for the particular Recognised Show

Junior Handler Format

- There is a cup for the winner.
- All the Junior Handlers get a certificate and prizes before they leave the ring.
- This year the prizes are .
- All Junior Handlers usually enter the ring at the same time with a Samoyed.
- Ages can range from 5 years to 17 years inclusive.
- Parents need to be ready to catch dogs with very young kids.
- When the judge is ready to award the winner the Ring Steward will give them the cup and then all the certificates and prizes will be handed out. (Assumes the judge is ok with this and it has been agreed before judging commences).
- The kids are to line up behind the winner to get their certificates and prizes
- A photo is taken if possible, of the judge with all the junior handlers.
- To keep the cup the junior handler needs to be a member of the club.
